Dustin passed out a map of Kansas showing all the counties for us to be able to see where the emergencies are located in Kansas. www.ksready.gov. One of the most costly emergencies is floods. Items to include in a basic emergency: Water, 1 gal per person/per day for at least 3 days for drinking and sanitation; food, battery-powered radio of a NOAA water radio and extra batteries; flashlight; 1st aid kit; whistle to signal for help; dust mask for filters contaminated air; moist towelettes, garbage bags; wrench or pliers to turn off utilities; can opener; prescription medications; glasses infant food, pet food and water; cash; change of clothing and shoes; fire extinguisher; matches in a waterproof container; activities for children; paper and pencil; plastic utensils, plates, cups, paper towels.


