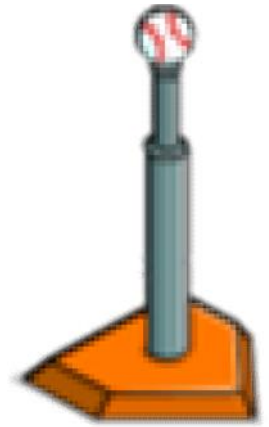
Registration is now open for Sunrise Optimist Summer Ball programs!
