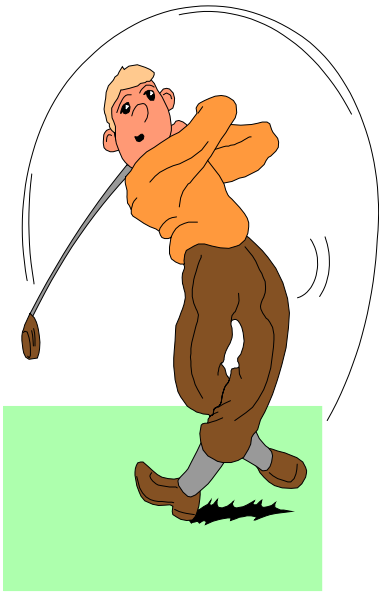
My personal odometer has recorded many a *mile*,

**MULLIGANS:** Mulligans are now included in the cost of registration. Mulligans will be limited to two mulligans per player. Use your mulligan ticket stubs for entry into the various raffles. Additional raffle tickets may be purchased. There will be many designated prize holes. Everybody will receive a door prize!

**ENTRIES:** All entry forms and checks, made payable to Sunrise Optimist Foundation, must be received no later than **July 20, 2012**. **Do not include the cost of the golf cart rental in your check.**

**CARTS:** There is a charge of \$24.00 for a twosome per cart, but do not include your cart rental fee in your check for entering the golf tournament.
