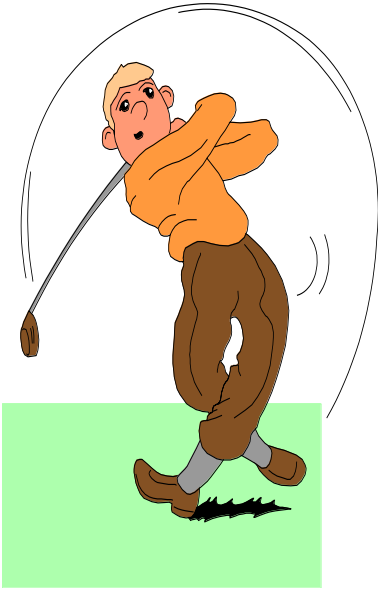

**TEE TIME:** 11:00 a.m., but be there by 10:30 for lunch and pre-tee instructions.

**LUNCH:** Sack lunches and soda pop will be available to all golfers at no charge.

**COST:** \$65.00 per person entry fee (\$260.00 per team). This fee includes green fees, mulligans and trophies for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams for two different flights.

**SPECIALS:** There will be prizes for Closest to the Line, Longest Drive, Closest to the Pin and Longest Putt.

**FORMAT:** Traditional four(4)-person scramble format with a shotgun start. The field of entries will be divided into two(2) flights with 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophies awarded in both flights. Any ties will be determined by handicap holes.

**MULLIGANS:** Mulligans are now included in the cost of registration. Mulligans will be limited to two mulligans per player. Use your mulligan ticket stubs for entry into the various raffles. Additional raffle tickets may be purchased. There will be many designated prize holes. Everybody will receive a door prize!

**ENTRIES:** All entry forms and checks, made payable to Sunrise Optimist Club, must be received no later than **July 18, 2014. Do not include the cost of the golf cart rental in your check.**

**CARTS:** There is a charge of \$24.00 for a twosome per cart, but do not include your cart rental fee in your check for entering the golf tournament. The carts will be paid for on the day of the tournament and will be handled by country Club personnel. Carts will be allocated on a "first come, first served" basis. **No Private Carts allowed on the Golf course.**

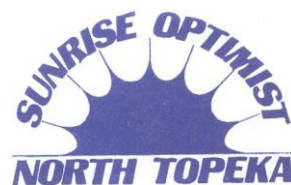

**You don't have to be a golfer to help us out and, besides, it'll be fun!**

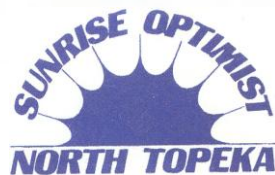

For an entry fee of \$10.00 (per ball) participants will be entered into The Great Golf Ball Drop to take place at Lake Perry County Club on Friday, July 25, 2014. Participants will be assigned a numbered golf ball or balls, depending on their purchase, and may enter multiple times.

Then, at the conclusion of the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Bob Cutter Golf Classic, all the numbered golf balls will be dropped from a lift hovering over a pre-selected hole on the course at Lake Perry Country Club. The first purchased golf ball in the hole, or the one closest to the hole, wins the grand prize. Additional targets will be placed on the area surrounding the hole for each of the other prizes.

1) If multiple balls go in the hole, the first purchased ball that is at the bottom of the hole will be determined the first place winner.

2) If no balls go in the hole, then the first purchased ball landing closest to the hole will be determined the winner. The winning ball closest to the hole will be determined by measuring from the center of the hole to the ball. The decision of the judges will be final.

You must be 18 years or older to enter and you DO NOT have to be present to win. The cash prizes will be based on a percentage of the proceeds, determined by the number of chances sold. 1<sup>st</sup> place = 15%, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 10%, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 5%. Winners will be notified by phone.
