July 10: Andrew Howell, Shawnee County Election Commissioner

He predicted 30% voter turnout for primary elections. Security of elections in Kansas is the best in the nation. No voting machine is connected to the internet. Each polling place takes a thumb drive to the election office where



the data is downloaded. Office servers require multiple layers of authentication with access physically in the election office only. Shawnee county acquired new voting equipment a few years ago and saved money by combined bidding with Sedgwick and Wyandotte counties.

Advanced voting is an option. If you don't mail an absentee ballot before election day, you can drop it off at any polling place. Government issued identification with photo is required.

Poll workers are always needed. Three hours of training is required. Long waiting lines for November election may occur if there is insufficient budget to pay a sufficient number of poll workers.

The voting process is greatly expedited.
