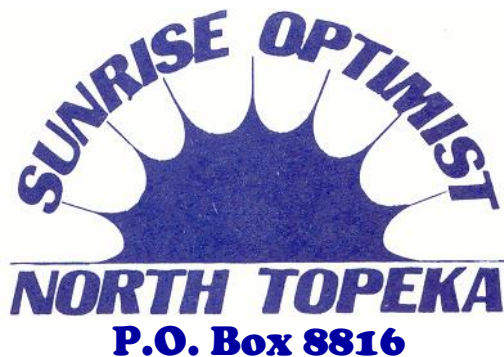

It is because of you we succeed!

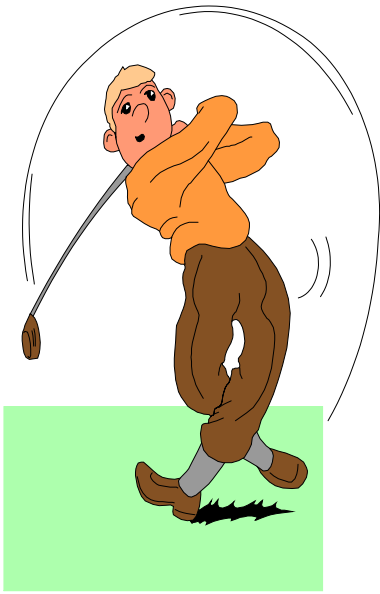
