PROGRAM:

Sept 18: Greg Inkman, Foundation for Aeronautical Education, flying remote control airplanes, local club started in 2003.

Remote control model airplane club has a flight area in the north Topeka river bottom, north of the Sardou bridge, 561 NE Sardou. Air show on Oct 6, 1:00 pm thru dark. Rain date is Oct 7. Dinner at 5:30 and gliders for kids at 5:00 pm.

Today’s model planes are no longer balsa wood and paper with fuel engine. Materials are flexible foam and lithium polymer batteries with brushless motor. Small planes with controller and recharger start at \$70.

The trainer plane sells for \$235 and comes with battery, transmitter and charger. He demonstrated the power of a F-16 model plane, weights 8 lbs, takes 2 batteries, and flies at 55-80 mph. He used the

Activity Bldg floor to demonstrate movement and engine power on a runway.

The club provides free flight instruction and one free trial flight on a controlled trainer (5 foot wingspan) for persons over age 4. You can’t crash it because the trainer has a transmitter with override button. And there is a panic button which sets the plane aright in flight. 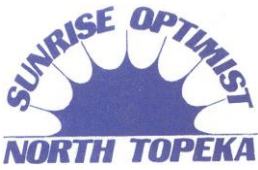

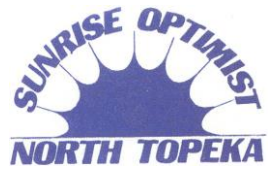

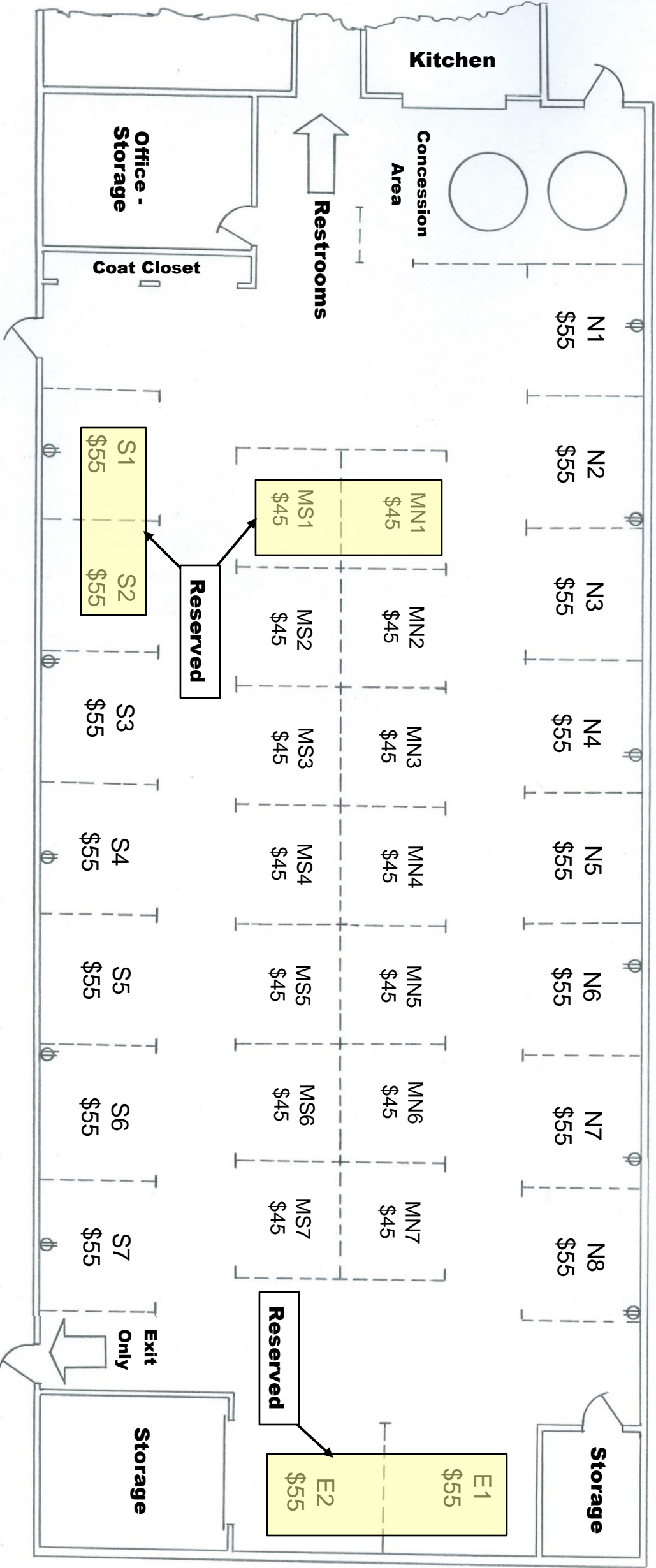

Our 8th Annual "Made from the Heart" Holiday Craft Fair will be November 3, 2018 at the Sunrise Optimist Club's Activity Center Building, 720 NW 50th, Topeka, KS. Booth spaces have either a 10' frontage x 9'depth, or 9' frontage x 8' depth. An 8 ft table and two(2) chairs are provided at each booth. Only handmade finished art and craft items are to be sold. No buy/sell, factory, imported, mass produced; wholesale or readymade items may be sold. **No raffles.**

Set up time for booths will be Friday, November 2, 3:00 PM – 8:00 PM and Saturday, November 3, 7:00AM - 8:30AM. Information booths will be open during set up times. Nothing may be attached to the walls. Extension cords will not be provided; please supply your own along with tape to secure the cords. Crafters agree to have someone operating their booth at all times. The booth shall remain open for business from 9:00 AM-4:00 PM and will NOT begin tearing down until 4:00 PM. Once the fair is over vacating the building by 6:00 PM is greatly appreciated. **NO SMOKING** in the buildings. Concessions will be available.

Crafters agree to assume full responsibility for loss or damage to their person or works. Reporting of sales tax collected will be the responsibility of the crafters.

Crafters who have not exhibited with us before agree to submit a photo(s) of their work with the contract/application. The photo(s) will not be returned.
