### Program:

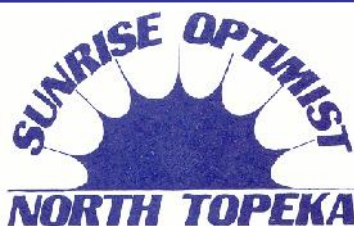
